The Pupil Premium is funding allocated to schools for the specific purpose of boosting the attainment of pupils from low-income families. Funding is based on children who have been registered for free school meals at any time in the last 6 years, further reinforcing the importance of making sure all those who qualify are actually registered.

Even if you (or your child) don't want to receive free school meals on a regular basis, there may be other educational benefits for them through the Pupil Premium. Your child(ren) can have a free school meal any day they choose.

Taking up free school meals has many benefits:

- By claiming Free School Meals families could be saving more than £400 per child per year, and your child(ren) will benefit from a eating a free healthy nutritious meal
- Schools could benefit directly by receiving money from the government. The government pays schools £1,300 for every primary child and £935 for every secondary child who registers for free school meals plus additional funding through the schools' budget. Your school could benefit from thousands of pounds.
- There may be help with the cost residential school trips (your child's school will have more information about this).
- There may be help with travel costs to school
- There may be help with school uniform costs (through your child's school).
