

Regular Church visits

As a school we visit Church regularly, both for worship and for different celebrations such as Harvest, Christingle and Pentecost. In addition to this, other places of worship are visited as part of the curriculum.

RE Lessons

RE lessons are inclusive and cover Christianity and at least one other major religion in each Year Group through the Discovery RE scheme of work, in line with the Pan-Berkshire RE syllabus.

Collective Worship will always be Christian in nature and will cover a wide range of different themes to capture the children's interest and teach them gospel values.
