

Communication and Language

- Develop listening skills in a range of situations
- Develop language and vocabulary to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in home and post office role play areas
- Initial teacher assessments

Physical Development

- Explore range of climbing, balancing and sliding apparatus, wheeled toys, bats and balls, hoops etc. in the outside area
- Make healthy snack and lunch choices and develop understanding of lunchtime routines
- Develop fine motor skills through creative art and handwriting activities

Understanding the World

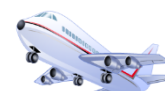
- Participate in class discussion about journeys and family holidays
